## Authors guidelines

The manuscript should be submitted in separate files: title page; main text file.

The title page should contain: the title; the full names of the authors; the author's institutional affiliations; the author's e-mail address.

As papers are double-blind peer reviewed, the main text file should not include any information that might identify the authors.

The main text file should be presented in the following order: Title, Abstract, and Keywords; Main text; References.

Please, upload title page and main text file as a separate document.

#### **Abstract**

You need to insert an abstract into this section by taking into account exactly the same format. Abstracts should be between 300 – 500 words. Please do not add any references. The authors need to clearly state the purpose of the study. Active sentences should be used in a study, and the authors avoid passive sentences where possible.

**Keywords:** keyword 1, keyword 2, keyword 3 (keywords should not exceed 3- 5 words)

# **Developmental and full paper requirements**

Authors must supply a structured paper set out under five sub-headings as below:

- 1. Introduction/Purpose;
- 2. Design/methodology/approach;
- 3. Findings;
- 4. Conclusion, originality/value of the paper, and Research limitations/implications;
- 5. References.

### Paper style

Paragraph titles and the body of the text should be following size 12.

You should cite publications in the text: (Rossi, 2006) using the first named author's name or (Rossi and Bianchi, 2006) citing both names, or (Rossi et al., 2006), when there are three or more authors. At the end of the paper a reference list in alphabetical order should be supplied in APA 7<sup>th</sup> style (<a href="https://aut.ac.nz.libguides.com/APA7th">https://aut.ac.nz.libguides.com/APA7th</a>). This is very important in an electronic environment because it enables your readers to exploit the Reference Linking facility on the database and link back to the works you have cited through CrossRef.

Notes or Endnotes should be used only if absolutely necessary and must be identified in the text by consecutive numbers, enclosed in square brackets and listed at the end of the article.

Figures, tables and charts should be supplied within the article itself.

Tables in the proceedings must be like the following example in terms of format. It must reflect the content; the title of the table should be placed on the top, aligned to the left.
